At the open house, the Town's elected officials, management, and staff will be seeking comments and suggestions on proposed projects and the needs of the community. All comments and suggestions will be considered in the development of the FY16 budget.

"City Commissioners and town staff are both very excited to meet with the public about next year's budget" explained Assistant City Manager Mike McClanahan. "Having a dialogue with residents and stakeholders about potential projects is important and benefits everyone."

The event will begin with an informal open house from 6:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. A brief overview presentation of the Town's finances will conclude the event between 7:00 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. The FY16 budget is the Town of Kingston Spring's financial plan and lasts between July 1, 2015 and June 30, 2016.
